The peoples of Sudan and South Sudan celebrated, yesterday 5th of August 2018, with joy and hope, the signing of Peace Agreement between the warring parties in 5-years long conflict and civil war in South Sudan.

The signing took place in Khartoum – Sudan, under the auspices of IGAD organization, which entrusted H.E. President of Sudan, Omar Hassan Elbashir as mediator. It was witnessed by the leaders of the IGAD and representatives of Regional and International organizations and followed eagerly by the people of South Sudan all over the world.

The two major parties of the conflict, the Government of South Sudan, led by H.E. President Salva Kiir Mayardit and the SPLM- In-Opposition led by Dr. Riek Machar, signed along with other opposition parties three agreements as follows:


- Khartoum Declaration Agreement
- Outstanding Security Arrangements
- Power Sharing Agreement

During the signing ceremony, the South Sudanese warring parties expressed their commitment to implement the agreements in letter and spirit, while the regional leaders expressed their readiness to support South Sudan to overcome its difficulty and to oversee the implementation and the transitional period.
